 Land adjacent to Flaxpool Garage, Flaxpool Hill, Crowcombe, Taunton, TA4 4AW
 Replacement of garage with erection of 3 No. garages and associated works

 Councillors discussed the proposals and resolved to object to the application on the following grounds:
- Overdevelopment of that part of the site adjacent to the road, when there would appear to be ample room for further garaging/workshops towards the rear of the site.
- The adequacy of the proposed visibility splay for vehicles approaching from the south (new Garage 3), and a more general concern about potentially increased vehicular movements off this rather dangerous stretch of road.
- The disproportionately high roof line of new Garage 2 when viewed from the road. Were the new garage to be turned through 90 degrees, a view of the gable end would be more visually appealing, and consistent with the other garages and remaining workshop.
- The need for roof lights in each of the three new garages is unclear in a purely commercial development of this nature, where bespoke internal lighting might seem more effective for vehicle garaging and restoration work? The Council notes that the existing garage/workshop that will remain has recently been re-roofed without the incorporation of roof lights, and understands that pre-application advice was not favourable towards a holiday letting proposal.
 - It is unclear how many people might be engaged in future commercial activity on

the site, but it is noted that no provision has been included for WC, etc facilities.
